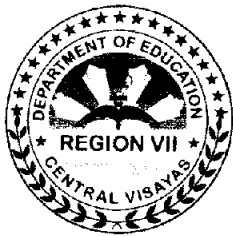

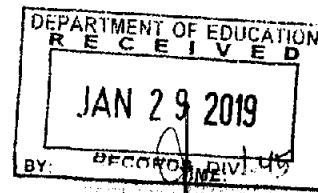
The specific objectives of the activity are as follows:

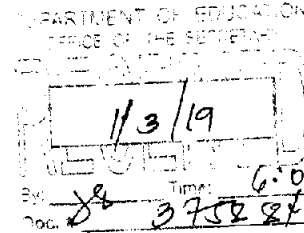
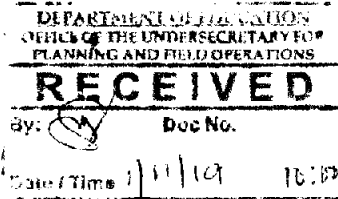
