1. This informs the field of the Heart to H.E.A.R.T. Talk initiated by the City of Bogu Population Office for the month of February. The activity aims to discuss and raise awareness among adolescents on the issues concerning HIV/AIDS/STI, Early Sexual Encounters, Adolescent Sexuality, Reproductive Health and Teenage Pregnancy.
2. Participants of the talk are Grade 10-12 students who will be gathered in one venue/classroom of the school for a half-day talk. All schools are advised to prepare audio and visual equipment (Laptop, sound system, projector with screen) for the conduct of the activity. And if the school lacks resources/venue, SSG Advisers are requested to coordinate with barangay officials in the locality for augmentation of facilities.


